Thank you for agreeing to contribute an article for Blue Pages. Here are our guidelines.

Please don't hesitate to get in touch if you have any queries or need further assistance.

ARTICLE LENGTH GUIDELINES:

1 page article: 500 words (with 1 large image) – 1200 words (without image)

2 page article: 1200 words (with 2/3 images) - 1500 words (with 1 image)

3 or 4 page articles: 1800 - 2200 words (articles of this length must include images)

NB. We strongly recommend all text is accompanied by images.

HOUSE STYLE:

Italics to be used for titles of books, productions, performances and exhibitions.

'Single quotations' to be used for titles of articles, quotations and direct speech

FORMAT:

Word doc. or Simple Text file.

If you would like you can send us a proposed layout for text and images as a pdf and we will try to accommodate your suggestions if at all possible. It should be noted, however, that we may not be able to use all the images or print them in colour.

IMAGES:

Separate jpg files and at the highest resolution possible.

Include full credits and caption for each image in a separate word document, numbering the images clearly.

BIOGRAPHY:

Include a short biography (no more than 100 words) to be placed at the end of your article.

Please let us know if you have any objections to your article being made available on the internet and on the SBTD website in the future.
